## SAMPLE UNITS YOU MAY STUDY

### LEVEL 2 DIPLOMA IN BUILDING MAINTENANCE & REFURBISHMENT

You will study knowledge based units that combine theory and practical work. Sample units include:

- Erecting and dismantling access/working platforms in the workplace
- Maintaining non-structural carpentry work in the workplace
- Repairing, replacing and renewing gates, posts and fencing in the workplace
- Applying paint systems by brush and roller in the workplace
- Hanging standard paper wallcoverings in the workplace
- Preparing background surfaces for plastering, tiling, panelling or painting/decorating in the workplace
- Repairing and maintaining structures in the workplace.

### Do I already need to have a job?

You should be working a minimum of 30 hours per week in a job. If you are unemployed, view our vacancies to apply for a job: [www.uxbridgecollege.ac.uk/apprenticeships](http://www.uxbridgecollege.ac.uk/apprenticeships)

### Can I start an apprenticeship after Year 11?

Yes, you can! Young people in England must stay in education or training until they turn 18. If you're looking for a different option after Year 11, an apprenticeship could be the answer for you!

### How long does it take to complete an apprenticeship?

You can complete an apprenticeship within 24 months, depending on your experience, competence and the company you are working in.

### How am I assessed?

Assessments are carried out in your workplace. Our assessor will come and assess you in your job role.

### How much does it cost?

16 - 23 year olds: there is no cost for you to do an apprenticeship and you will be paid a wage.

### What's next after I complete my apprenticeship?

#### *Further Study -*

On successful completion of a Level 2 Apprenticeship, you could progress on to a Level 3 in Building Maintenance & Refurbishment or further training.

#### *Career opportunities -*

You may find employment as an Estate Property Engineer, Building Maintenance Operatives etc.
