<b>Key Assessment Task 1</b>	<b>W/C 19<sup>th</sup> April</b>	<b>Paper 1</b> (Drama text) <i>All My Sons</i>	75 minutes	x 1 paper 25 marks Students will answer a question based on an extract from the set text and analyse themes, character, author's intent, whilst drawing on the rest of the text for wider contextual analysis.
<b>Key Assessment Task 2</b>	<b>W/C 3<sup>rd</sup> May</b>	<b>Paper 2</b> (Society and the Individual) <i>The Great Gatsby</i> and <i>The Whitsun Weddings</i>	75 minutes	x 1 paper 30 marks Students will evaluate the effectiveness of methods used by the two chosen writers in presenting individuals as outsiders from society whilst considering the use of linguistic and literary features, connections across texts and relevant contextual factors.
<b>Terminal Key Assessment Task (Mock)</b>	<b>W/C 17<sup>th</sup> May</b> <b>Separate timetable to follow</b>	<b>Paper 2</b> (Comparing Voices) Voices in Speech and Writing: An Anthology	75 minutes	x1 Paper 30 marks Students will answer a question on two extracts comparing how the speakers shape their language to create a sense of voice whilst considering linguistic and literary features, the influence of audience and purpose as well as the context of the texts.
