Reuse – Renew - Recycle

There are 3 tasks in total:

1. Students are required to find a garment and revamp it in to a wearable item of clothing or accessory (hat, bag etc.)
 - This could be a garment that they or someone else no longer wears (family member?)
 - You could also visit charity shops for garments
2. Research designers that have designed collections based on recycling and create a minimum of 2 studies that relate directly to your garment construction providing evidence of how this inspiration has informed your own creation.
