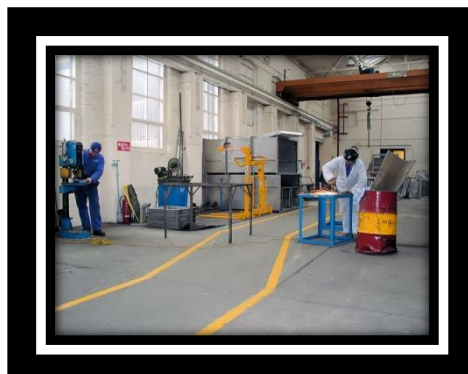


IOSH Working Safely



What is IOSH Working Safely?

The 'IOSH Working Safely Certificate' or 'Passport' course is designed to train employees to ensure that their actions contribute to health and safety in the workplace and that individual responsibilities are clearly understood.

Course aims

To make employees at all levels aware of their responsibilities for safety toward themselves, colleagues and others affected by work activities.

What will I learn?

By the end of the course the delegates should be able to:

- Identify the hazards and evaluate risks in the workplace
- Use appropriate workplace precautions for specific risks or seek advice on workplace precautions
- Assist managers in preparing written risk assessments
- Follow their organisation's health and safety policy
- Co-operate and communicate on health and safety matters
- Carry out work activities without risk to themselves or others
- Report relevant accidents and incidents monitor their own activities, and assist managers in active monitoring.

On successful completion of a short answer test the delegate will receive an IOSH accredited certificate or if you prefer, a card, as it's more handy and portable. The robust plastic card includes a number of other security features and an expiry date, to make sure that training is up to date.

The assessment procedure for this course consists of a short 20-minute closed book 10 question multiple-choice paper and a hazard spotting exercise.
